**WIND WARNING FOR FISHERMEN FOR
KERALA, KARNATAKA COASTS AND LAKSHADWEEP AREA**

SYNOPTIC SITUATION:

Yesterday's Depression over Strait of Malacca moved westwards and intensified into a deep depression over the same region at 2330 hours IST of yesterday, the 25th November, 2025. It moved nearly westwards and intensified into a cyclonic storm "Senyar" [Pronunciation: 'Sen-yar'] and lay centered at 0530 hours IST of today, the 26th November, 2025 over Strait of Malacca and adjoining northeast Indonesia near latitude 5.0°N and longitude 98.0°E. It further moved west- southwestwards and crossed Indonesia coast near 4.9°N between 0730-0830 hours IST with wind speed of 70-80 kmph gusting to 90kmph and lay centered at 0830 hours IST of today, the 26th November, 2025 over coastal areas of northeast Indonesia near latitude 4.9°N and longitude 97.8°E. It is very likely to continue to move west-southwestwards and maintain the intensity of cyclonic storm till 27th early morning. Thereafter, it is very likely to recurve eastwards with gradual Weakening during subsequent 24hours.

The low-pressure area over southwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining areas of South Sri Lanka & Equatorial Indian Ocean lay as a well-marked low-pressure area over southwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining areas of Southeast Sri Lanka & Equatorial Indian Ocean at 0530 hours IST of today, the 26th November, 2025. It persisted over the same region at 0830 hours IST of today, the 26th November, 2025. It is very likely to move nearly north-northwestwards and intensify into a depression during next 24 hours. Thereafter, it is very likely to intensify further and continue to move north-northwestwards across southwest Bay of Bengal towards North Tamil Nadu & Puducherry coasts during subsequent 48 hours.

Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 50 kmph to 60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph will prevail over south Andaman Sea and adjoining, some parts of southeast Bay of Bengal.
DAY-3: (28.11.2025)	Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph will prevail over Comorin area, over southwest & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal, some parts of westcentral Bay of Bengal, along and off south Andhra Pradesh coast. Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph will prevail over Gulf of Mannar, along and off Sri Lanka, Tamil Nadu coasts, many parts of southwest Bay of Bengal.
DAY-4: (29.11.2025)	Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph will prevail over Comorin area, over southwest & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal, many parts of westcentral Bay of Bengal, along and off south Andhra Pradesh coast. Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph will prevail over Gulf of Mannar, along and off Sri Lanka, Tamil Nadu coasts, over Gulf of Mannar, many parts of southwest Bay of Bengal. Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 50 kmph to 60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph will prevail over parts of southwest Bay of Bengal off north Sri Lanka coast.
DAY-5: (30.11.2025)	Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph will prevail over Comorin area, over southwest & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal, many parts of westcentral Bay of Bengal, along and off south Andhra Pradesh coast. Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph will prevail over Gulf of Mannar, along and off Sri Lanka, Tamil Nadu coasts, over Gulf of Mannar, many parts of southwest Bay of Bengal. Squally weather with wind speeds reaching 50 kmph to 60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph will prevail over parts of southwest Bay of Bengal off north Tamil Nadu coast

Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas during the above mentioned period.

Fishermen out at deep sea over Bay of Bengal are advised to return to coast immediately.

THUNDERSTORM WARNING: Thunderstorm accompanied by lightning is very likely to occur at one or two places over Kerala on 26th & 27th November 2025.


